- The Entity now invites eligible consultants to submit sealed expressions of interest for Consultancy services to conduct waste flow surveys and characterization for energy generation in Jinja and Masaka cities
- Aim of the study: To conduct waste flow surveys and characterization of waste for energy generation in Jinja and Masaka cities. This information is critically urgent for planning and management of investment in energy, provide efficient and effective services, and plan for future needs and track progress towards city recycling goals. Specifically, the study will undertake:
  - Waste characterization/ Composition Survey (WCS) to gather information on Physical Composition of MSW collected
  - Customer or Public Opinion Survey (COS) to gather information on public opinion on current waste management.
  - Market studies to assess current and future markets of targeted wastes
  - Energy potential assessments to assess the relative energy values of the different categories of wastes.
- Specific objectives:**
  - To conduct waste flow surveys and characterize waste generated in Masaka and Jinja cities.
  - To gather information on public opinion on current waste management in Masaka and Jinja cities through Customer or Public Opinion Survey (COS).
  - To assess current and future markets of targeted wastes through a market study.
